## DECLARATION OF INTENTION

(Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof)

I, George Romano, aged 23 years,

occupation miner, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion dark, height 5 feet 8 inches, weight 142 pounds, color of hair dark, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks scar on left cheek

; I was born in Caccamo, Italy, on the 25th day of October, anno Domini 1895; I now reside at 146 Gordon St. Gaselle, Illinois. I emigrated to the United States of America from Caccamo, Italy on the vessel\* Marsilia; my last foreign residence was Caccamo, Italy.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Nicolas Emmanuel III King of Italy, of which I am now a <sup>citizen</sup> subject; I arrived at the port of New Orleans, in the State of Louisiana on or about the 24th day of September, anno Domini 1893; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
